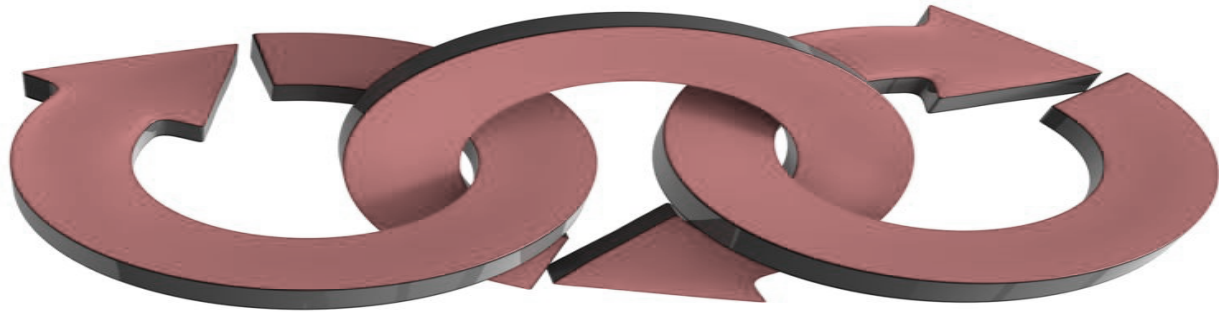


Achieving a World Class Safety Culture

This interactive workshop presents a logical, common sense approach to changing individual behavior and improving safety culture. Participants will learn specific, practical ways to measure the safety culture of their organizations and to plan culture change strategies that improve safety performance.
